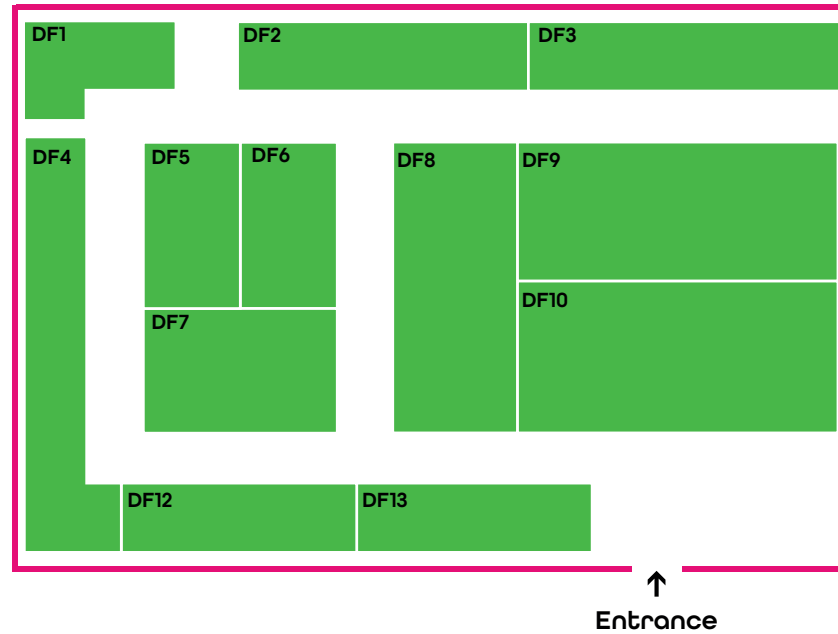

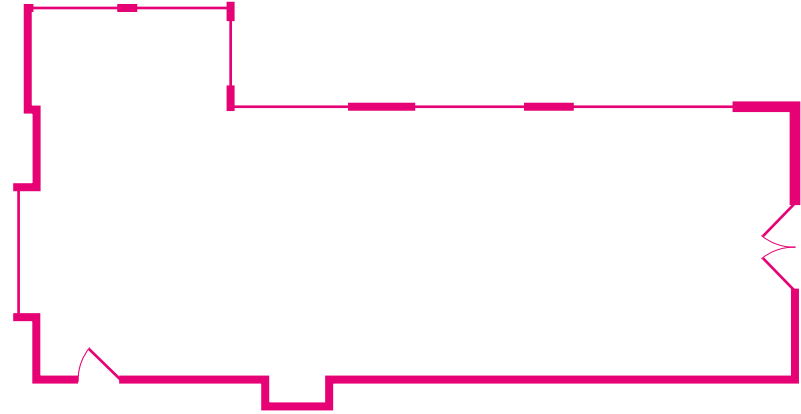


Floor plan

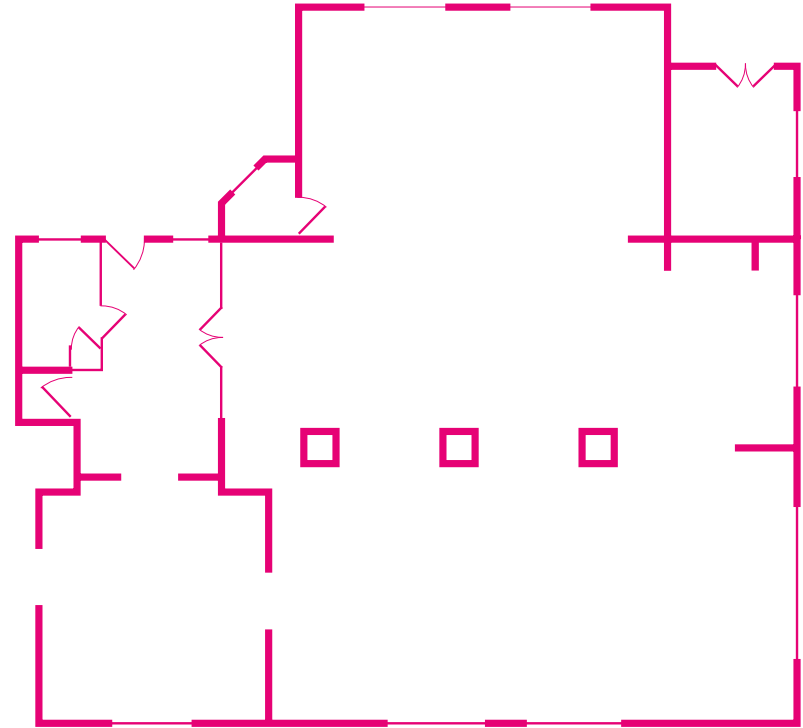

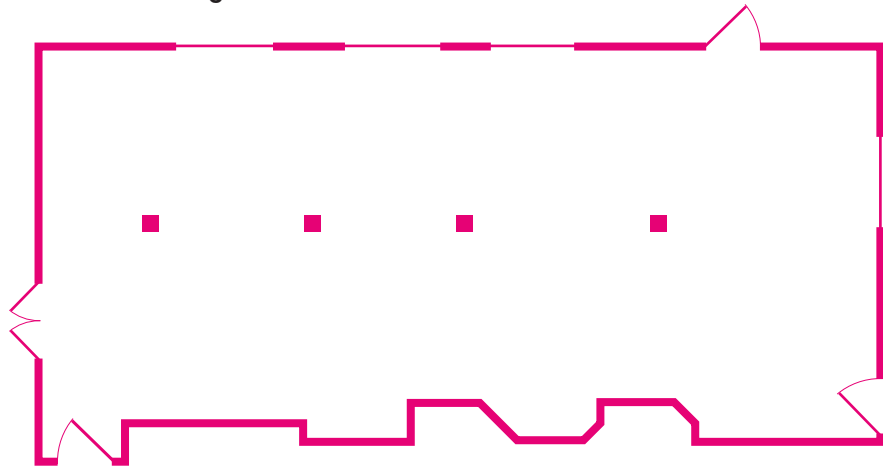

Studio Smithfield is a new creative event space located at London's historic Smithfield Market, an area that will form a new hub within CDW's South district for 2025.

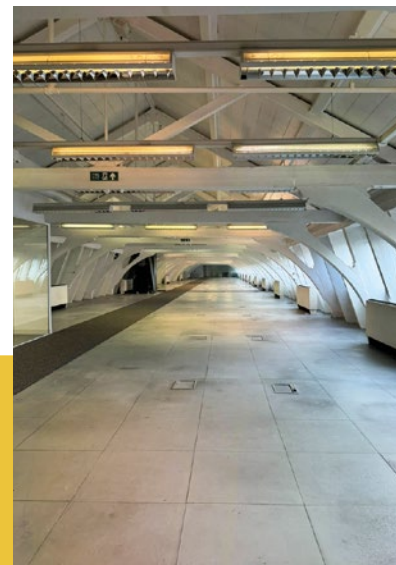
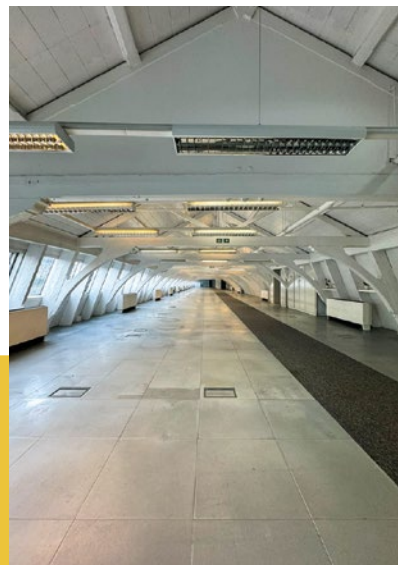

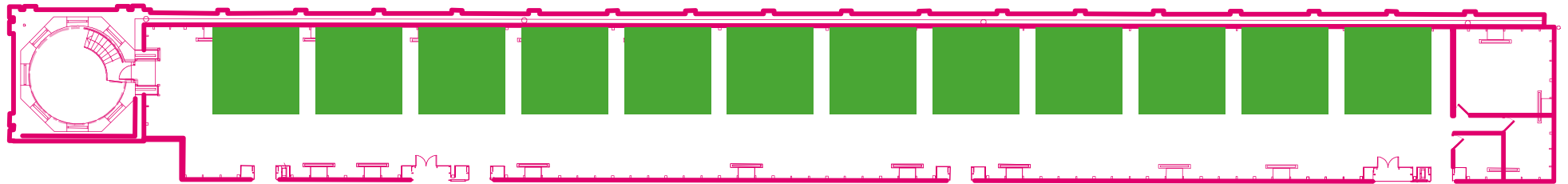
